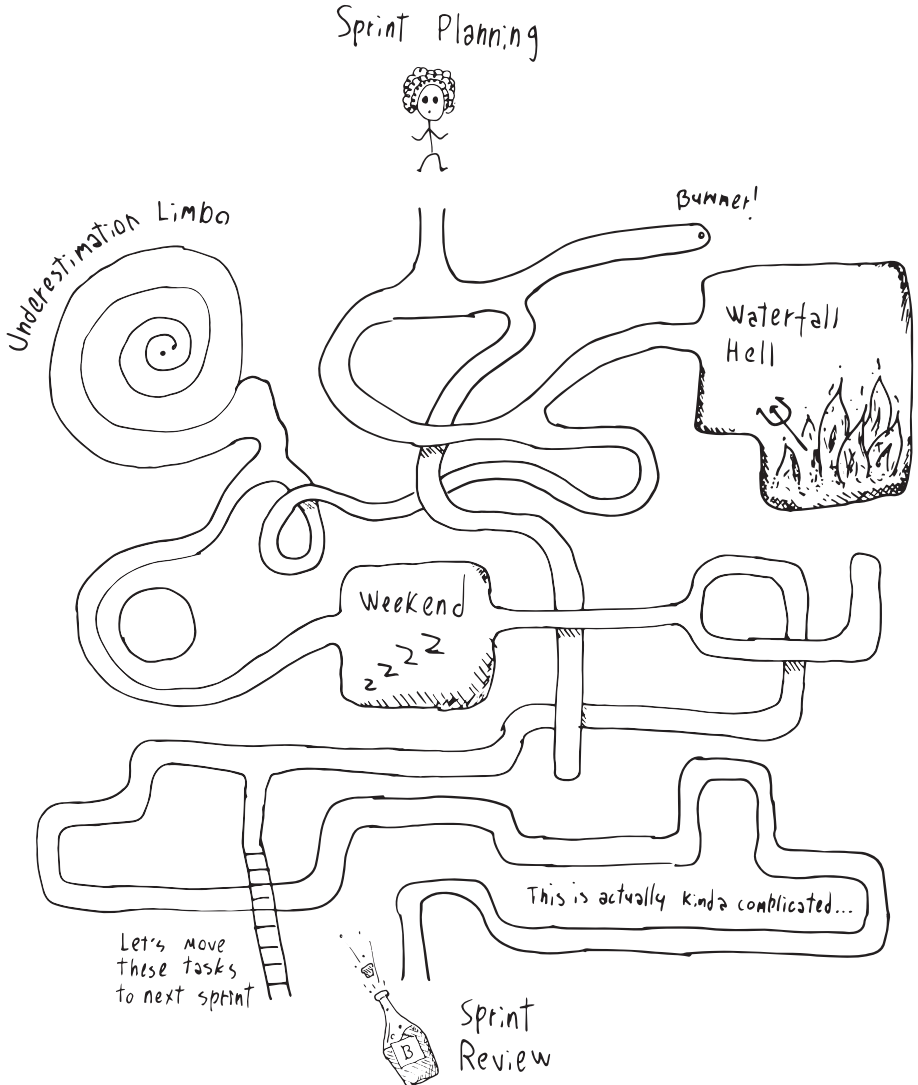

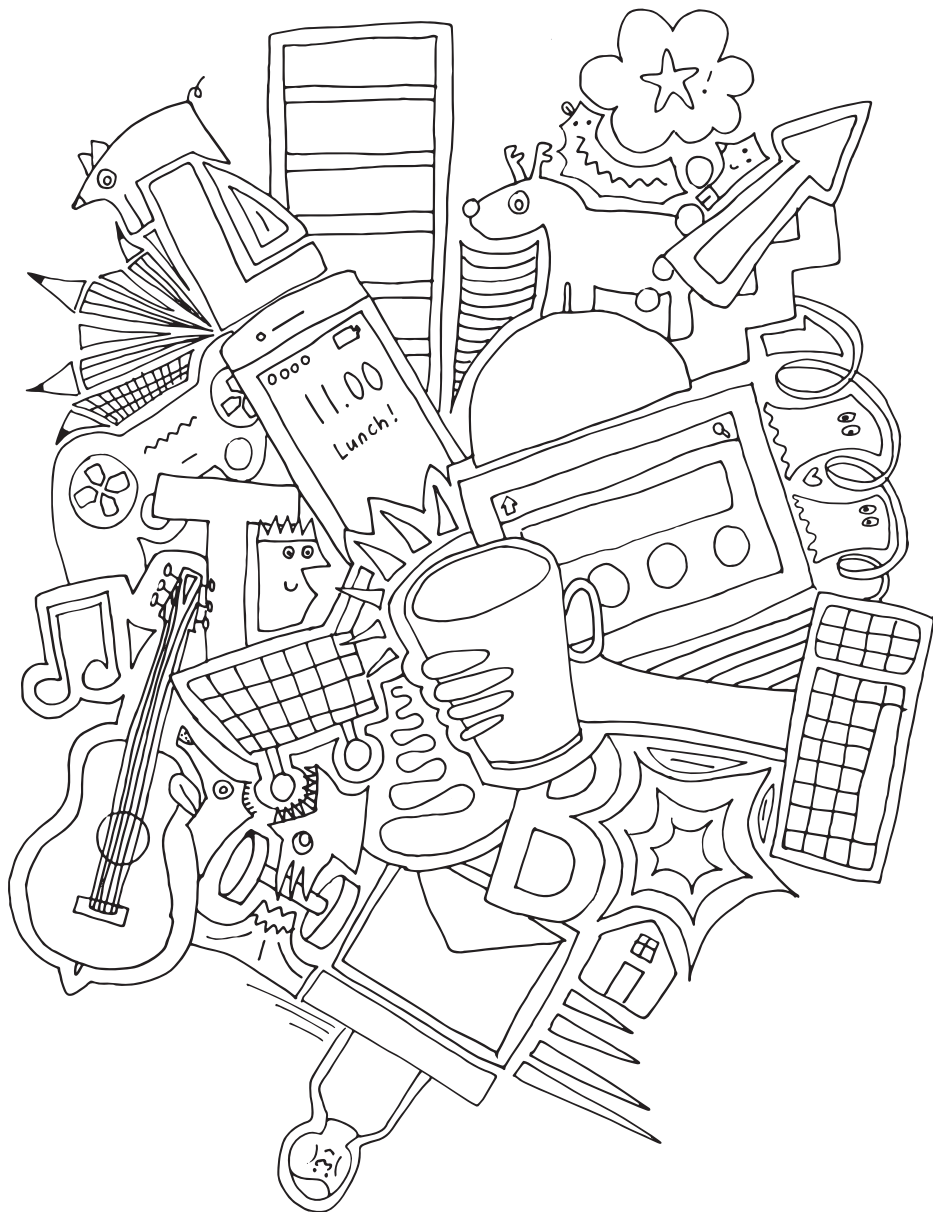



The systems analyst said, "No, I think we should have a specialist look at it."

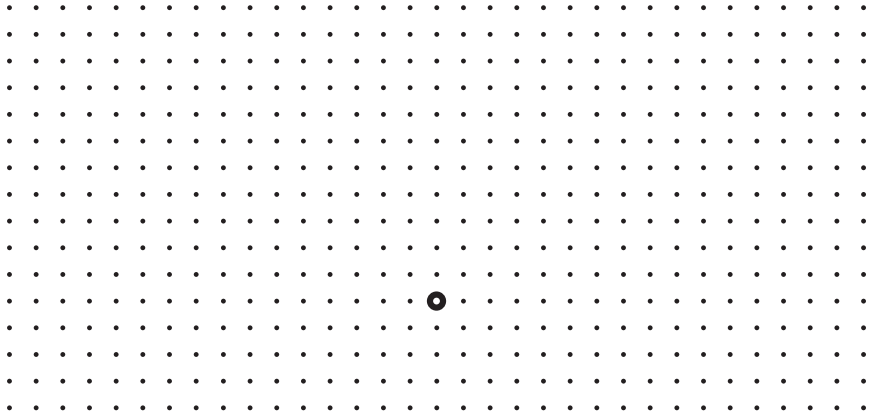
The programmer said, "I think we should push it back up the hill and see if it does it again."
